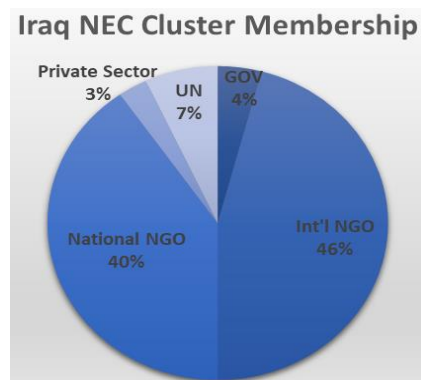


Iraq National Education Cluster Localization Analysis, 2020

Membership and Leadership:



47% of the Iraq National Education Cluster (NEC) is made up of **local actors** (NNGO, Government, and Private Sector), of which National NGOs (NNGO) make up the majority.*

International Actors make up the majority of membership by 53% (including INGO and UN Agencies).

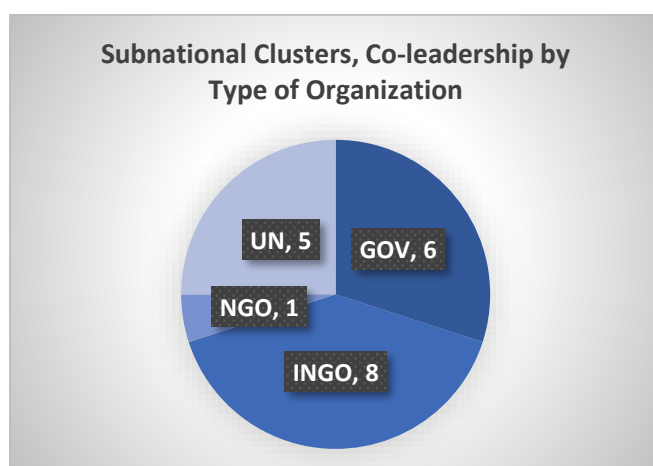
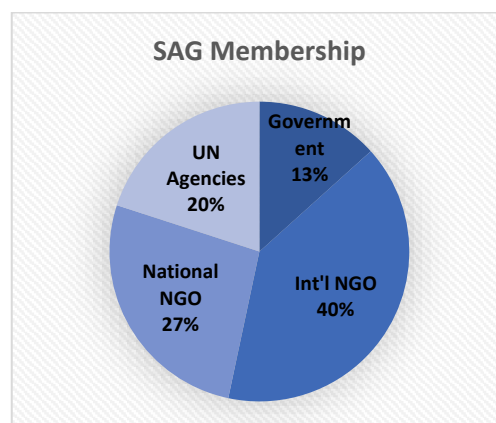
Co-lead Organizations: UNICEF and Save the Children

The co-lead agencies closely collaborate with MoE Federal and MoE Kurdistan Region of Iraq (KRI).

** Cluster membership is defined as being on the cluster's contact list and attending meetings.*

60% of the Strategic Advisory Group (SAG) seats are filled by International actors. SAG is the main advisory body and consultation organ of the cluster.

National actors (both NNGO and Government) make up 40% of the SAG.

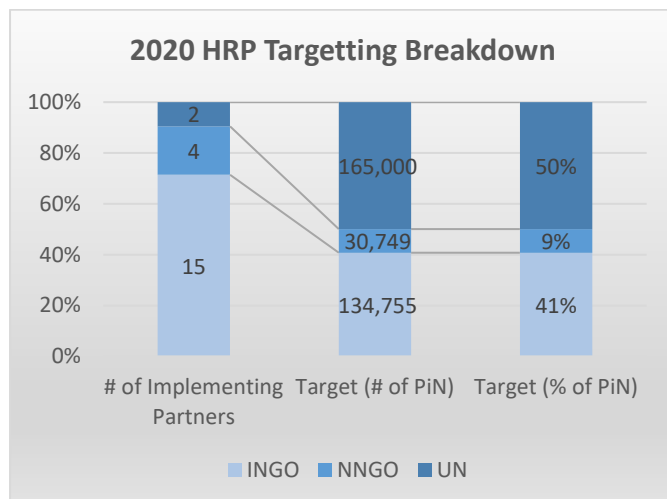


Only 1 national NGO co-lead a Subnational Cluster.

13 of Subnational Clusters Co-leadership seats are occupied by the international actors, including INGO and UN agencies.

Service Delivery (Children and Adults):

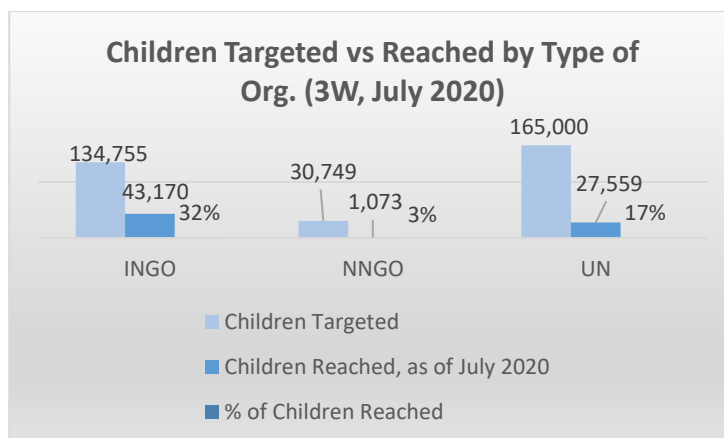


21 organizations shared their targets for 2020 HRP, including 15 INGOs, 4 NNGOs, and 2 UN agencies.

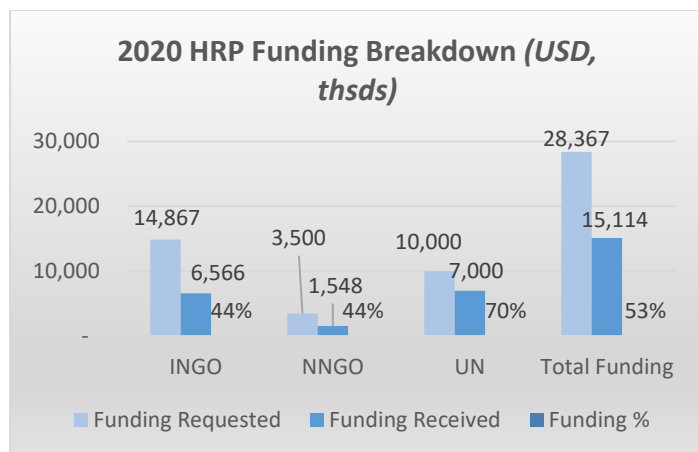
The share of national NGO's in targeting is 9%, whereas UN agencies target 50% of the PiN, and INGOs target 41% of Education PiN.

** Some NGO's share of targets are estimated by calculation.*

According to the AI reporting, national partners reached 3% of their targets.



Funding:



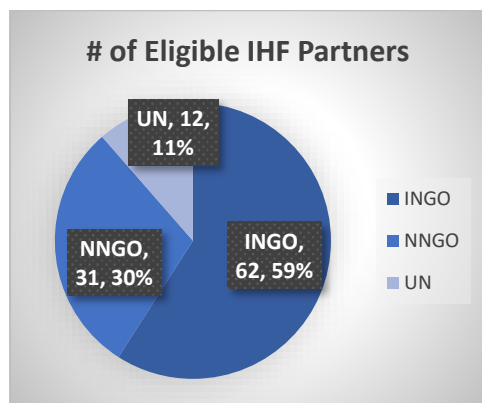
20 organizations submitted their funding request in the 2020 HRP.

Total level of *reported* funding for all Education Cluster members is at 53%*.

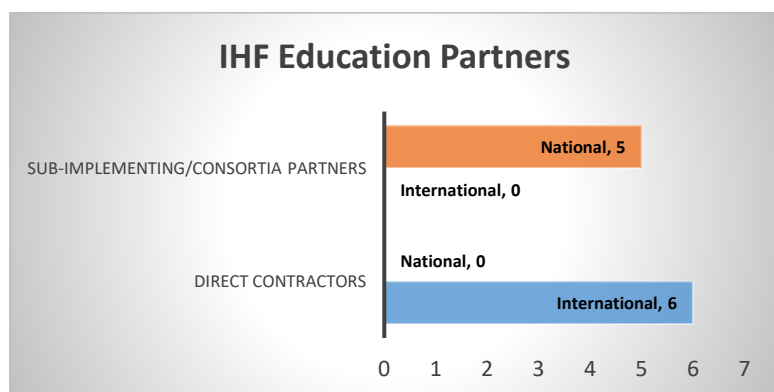

Access to Pooled Funds:



As of May 2020, Iraq Humanitarian Fund (IHF) has 105 eligible partners from all clusters including Education, out of which national partners make up 30%.

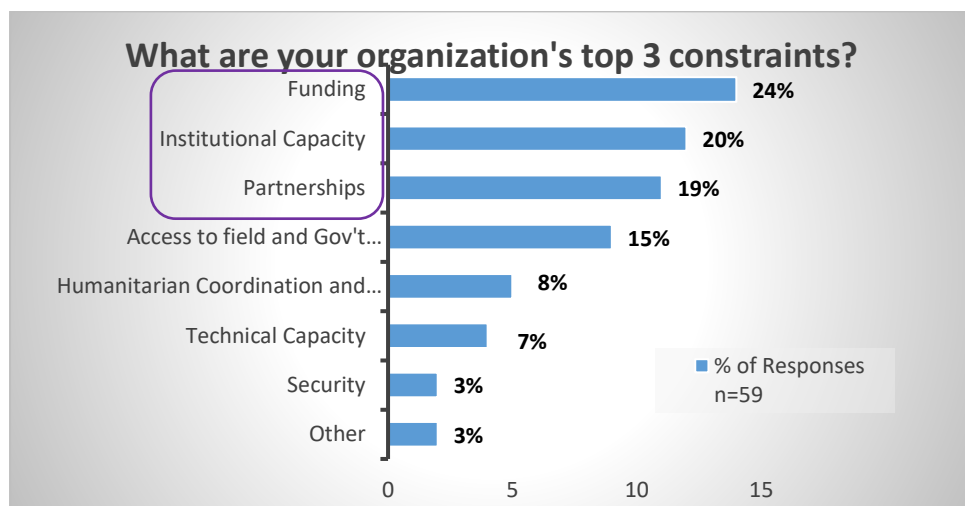
